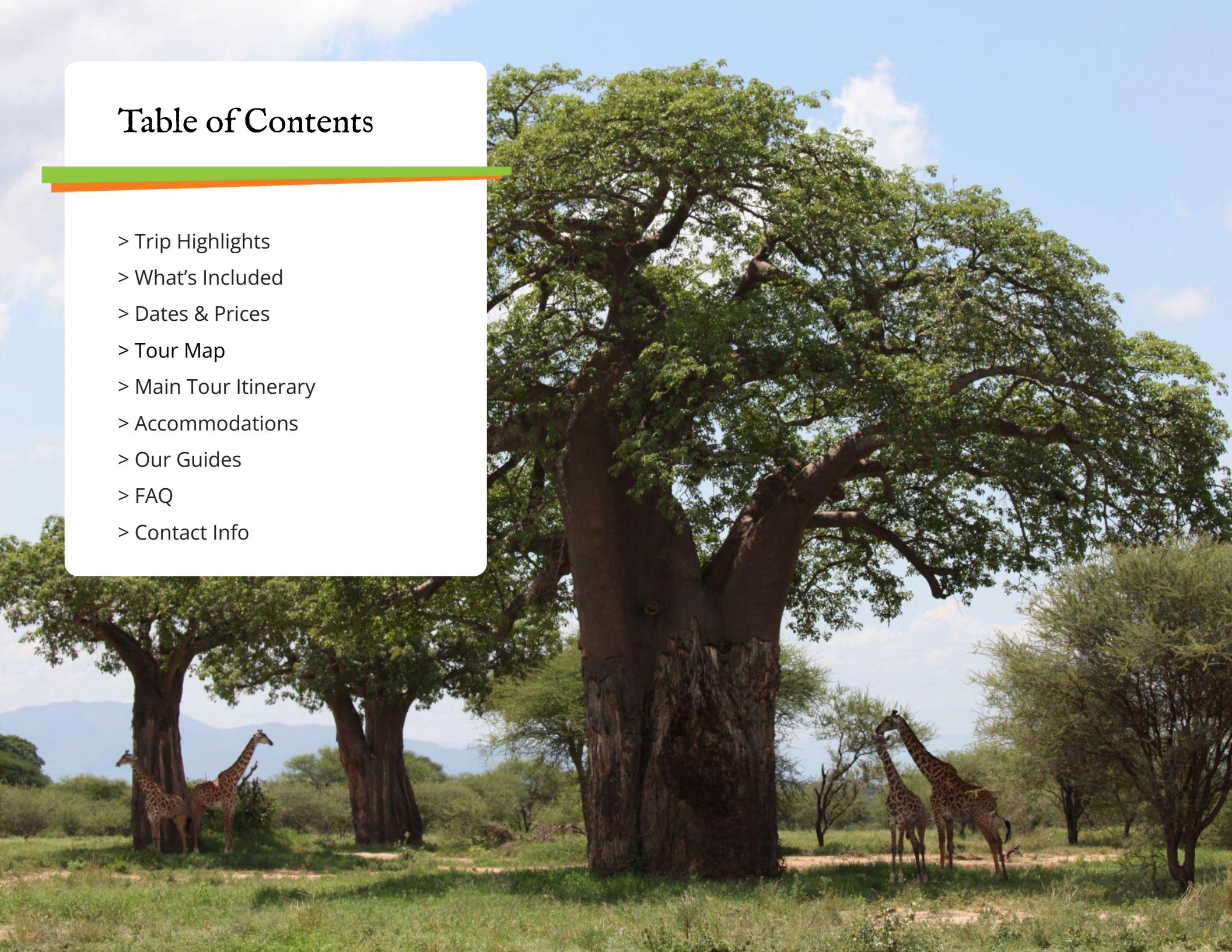




Tanzania: Great Migration Safari

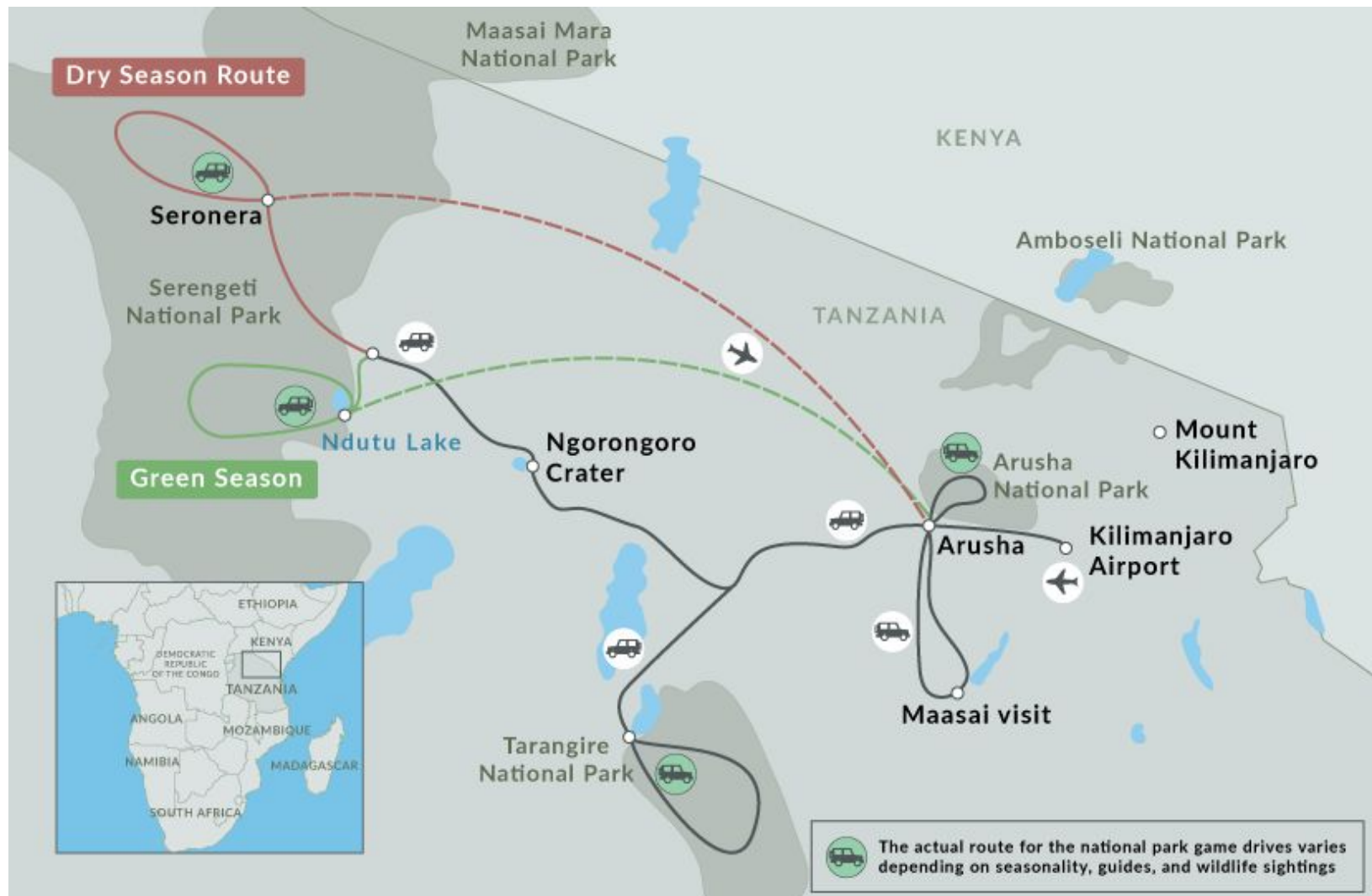

Tour Map



The itinerary is almost the same in both seasons. The only difference is where we stay in the Serengeti, which is matched with where most of the wildlife is seen during that time of the year. During the green season (January/February) we stay in South Serengeti and during the dry season (May-July) we stay in Central Serengeti.



TOUR ITINERARY



Day One

After arriving in Tanzania, your guide will pick you up at the Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) and bring you to the lodge. Surrounded by beautiful trees, maintained gardens, and the occasional monkey, this lodge is a secluded and relaxing place to begin our East African journey.

Depending on arrival times, we'll either host a Meet & Greet before dinner tonight or after breakfast tomorrow morning.

Day Two

After breakfast today we depart for Arusha National Park. This park has amazing colobus monkey viewing, and giraffes, buffalos, hippos, hyenas, and zebras can all be seen around the lakes and craters.

A real highlight of this park is the opportunity for a guided ranger hike followed by a picnic overlooking amazing landscapes and wildlife. We'll take a lovely afternoon game-drive before returning to the lodge.

Day Three

After breakfast, we'll drive two hours south from Arusha to visit a Maasai *boma*, a family compound made up of huts for the patriarch and each of his wives. An English-speaking Maasai will act as our guide and interpreter. We might see the cows and goats leave the boma for pasture. You'll have an opportunity to see the inside of a hut and participate in a traditional dance.

Afterward, the Maasai guide will give a talk where he explains and shares information about their culture, gender norms, and beliefs. We're also welcome to ask questions.

Following a fresh and filling bush lunch you can either go on a short, guided walking safari escorted by a ranger or stay with the vehicles and drive to a beautiful nearby lake where we'll observe birds and meet up with the walkers.

In the late afternoon we'll drive back to the lodge in Arusha for dinner and a quiet evening.

Day Four

We'll check out of the lodge today and drive southwest to Tarangire National Park, a hidden gem of Tanzania. The landscape is gorgeous and sightings of zebras, wildebeest, antelopes, and lions are very common amongst the park's iconic baobab trees. Tarangire is also known for some of the greatest concentrations of elephants in the world.

We'll enjoy a game drive and stop at a scenic spot for a picnic. When the sun gets lower in the sky we'll check in at a deluxe tented camp situated inside the National Park, sit down for dinner, and fall asleep in a comfortable bed.

Day Five

We'll start the day off with a morning game drive in Tarangire National Park. There's usually a lot of activity during morning hours when the light is golden and the heat of the day has yet to set in.

We'll leave the park and drive towards Ngorongoro Conservation Area, stopping for lunch along the way. Once we're past the gate, a series of unpaved switchbacks take us up to the crater rim. We'll stay at a tented lodge near the rim tonight.

Day Six

We'll get an early start and head down into the Ngorongoro Crater for morning game drive. The crater measures 100 square miles and is the world's largest unbroken caldera. Today it's home to the critically endangered black rhinoceros, as well as one of the densest lion populations in Africa. Other animals to look out for are hippos, zebras, elephants, wildebeest, and more!

We spend the afternoon driving to the famous Serengeti National Park, deep into the heart of wild Africa.

Day Seven

With over 5,600 square miles of land, every day spent in the Serengeti will bring new landscapes and wildlife into focus.

Depending on the timing, you may get a chance to watch the unfolding of a year-long migration filled with danger and drama.

Watch as hundreds of thousands of wildebeests, zebras, and gazelles make their annual 500 mile journey, while lions and cheetahs pursue and crocodiles wait for a chance to prey.

The experience includes: a flight of 90 minutes, a bush breakfast, a champagne toast after the flight, and transportation from the lodge to the launch site and back.

This activity offers a peaceful, panoramic perspective of the areas you've explored on the ground. From above, you can witness the beauty of the plains, spot chance wildlife, and soak in the stunning morning light as the day begins.

Maksoru Spring Lodge

Nights 1, 2, 3 & 9

Located on the southern slopes of Mt. Meru, this lodge is the ideal base for our safari and nearby activities. Set within lush gardens alive with birds and the occasional monkey, it feels like a hidden sanctuary. Maksoru Spring Lodge is a newly built property, owned and operated by our local partner. Balloon Camp Tarangire

Night 4

Situated in the heart of Tarangire National Park and overseeing Tarangire River, this bush camp offers convenience, comfort, and immediate access to the incredible scenery and wildlife. Each deluxe safari tent features an ensuite bathroom with a shower, vanity, and flush toilets. The common area includes a lounge, dining room, and a small swimming pool, while friendly staff and chefs keep us comfortable, happy, and well-fed.



Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge

Night 5

This lodge is the perfect stop before we head into the Ngorongoro Crater. Featuring locally inspired décor and private stone balconies overlooking the crater, you can enjoy an elegant retreat that blends modern luxuries with the beauty of the surrounding natural landscape.

Amenities include complimentary Wi-Fi, coffee/tea making stations, and extensive viewing terraces throughout the property that offer stunning panoramic views.

Situated on the rim of the crater, the lodge's location is ideal as we will be among the first to descend into the crater at sunrise, which is teeming with wildlife.

As is common with boutique hotels, room sizes and views are often different within the same property. Please note that we assign guest rooms on a first come, first serve basis. No exceptions.

Ang'ata Migration Ndotu Camp

Nights 6, 7, 8

The Ndotu Camp is a classic tented safari camp located in the southern part of Serengeti National Park. This is a seasonal bush camp discretely set above a marsh, which allows safe observation of wildlife just below the camp, as well as of Lake Ndotu in a distance.

This location is ideal to experience the Great Wildebeest Migration in full swing and you can expect the same standard, Tanzanian hospitality, and comfort as we've gotten used to from the other camps.



Ang'ata Serengeti Camp

Nights 6, 7, 8

The Serengeti Camp is a classic tented safari camp located in Seronera, the central area of the Serengeti National Park. This bush camp is a tranquil haven hosted by cheery staff and offers picturesque views of the surrounding plains and valleys. Wildlife often travels within view of the camp.

Situated at a prime location within the park, it provides incredible access to seasonal migrations and the region's breathtaking scenery.

Depending on the season and wildlife activity, our accommodations for nights 6 - 8 varies. During the green season (January/February), we will stay at a migration camp in the Ndotu area, while during the dry season (July), we will stay in the Seronera area of the Serengeti National Park.



Our Guides

We work with a carefully selected crew of expert guides led by Victor John Mushi. Our guides are from Tanzania and are trained experts of the region's geography, natural history, flora, fauna, and Maasai culture, history, and customs. All of our guides are personable, professional, courteous, friendly, and excited to show our guests some of the most incredible parts of Tanzania. All of our guides are vetted, trained, and hold relevant certifications to guide in Tanzania and inside its beautiful National Parks.

We typically assign guides to specific departure dates a few months out and you'll receive more information about your specific guide or guides before you travel.



GENERAL INFORMATION

FAQ - GETTING THERE AND BACK

Is This Trip For Me?

- Our Great Migration Safari requires moderate mobility and physical fitness. You should be able to walk unassisted on uneven terrain without established trails for at least one mile, walk with moderate elevation gains to 100 feet (30 meters), and comfortably enter and exit vans, buses, and small aircraft without assistance. You will spend a significant amount of time in our safari vehicles on bumpy roads and across grasslands during game drives, which can last up to five hours. You must be comfortable with sitting for long periods of time and handling dust. The itinerary includes a scenic flight using a safe, but small aircraft.

Please note that the minimum age for all of our tours is 12. Some activities may also have specific age restrictions. However, we may be able to make exceptions in certain cases. Do you offer private tours?

- Yes, our itineraries can be arranged as private tours for small groups from 6-18 people, depending on the season and itinerary. You and your group can travel together on a more personalized trip while still benefiting from the same guides, accommodations, and activities included in our regular departures. When should I arrive in Tanzania?

- You can arrive anytime at the Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) on Day 1 of this itinerary.

What do I need to do to prepare for my arrival and journey?

- Send us your flight itinerary and we will organize an airport pick-up for you (included). A Gondwana Ecotours representative will be waiting for you at the airport with a sign with your name on it or the Gondwana Ecotours logo. Make sure you travel with a valid passport (must be valid for at least six months after your stay) and your visa will be issued upon arrival in Tanzania if you did not secure it ahead of time.

What if I want to come and explore before Day 1?

- If you decide to come before Day 1 we can book a room for you at our first lodge and we will of course organize transportation from the airport to the lodge when you land.

What should I do in preparation for my departure?

- You can depart at the Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) anytime on Day 10 of your Safari. Most guests depart in the afternoon.

Can you cater to my dietary restrictions?

- We cater to common dietary restrictions and can accommodate most common diets with advanced notice. After registering for a tour, we provide a Registration Form to collect your dietary information, which we share with our vendors to make necessary accommodations. If you have specific questions about an uncommon dietary restriction, please email our Guest Services department at info@gondwanaecotours.com, and we will explore possible options to match your needs.

What if I want to stay longer?

- For those of you who will be staying longer, feel free to ask us for help! We offer a [pre-trip trek to the top of Mount Kilimanjaro](#), the tallest peak on the African continent. What's the difference between the different times of year that this safari is offered?

- We offer this tour in two different seasons and both are fantastic times to visit. The dry season runs from June to October. Rainfall is rare during this period and the weather is typically cooler and often hazy or cloudy. Temperatures vary by location and altitude, but are generally mild and range from 54°F to 73°F. The green season is named for the grasses and vegetation fueled by rain. The heaviest rains usually occur from mid-March to May, and a shorter period of rain occurs from November to mid-January. Temperatures often range from 55°F to 82°F.

The itinerary is almost identical in both seasons. The only difference is where we stay in the Serengeti, which is matched with where most of the wildlife is seen during that time of the year. During the green season we stay in South Serengeti and during the dry season we stay in Central Serengeti.

How do I sign up?

- Secure your spots with a \$500 USD per person deposit (via phone, email, or on our [website](#)) that is fully refundable within 30 days of payment, provided the trip is at least 121 days away at the time of cancellation.
